Redding Rancheria Community Fund grants \$96,290 to local schools

Redding, CA June 28, 2007-The Redding Rancheria Community Fund a fund of the Shasta Regional Community Foundation announces grant funding to 14 local schools in Shasta and Trinity Counties for physical fitness and the arts in the amount of \$96,290.

The RRCF has granted approximately \$980,000 since its inception in 2002. The following organizations received funds:

- Acorn to Oaks Charter School \$2,000 for musical instruments
- Anderson Union High School \$4,500 for football equipment
- East Cottonwood Elementary \$6,500 for musical instruments
- Enterprise Elementary School District \$10,000 for their start up music program
- French Gulch \$6,500 for track and field fitness restoration project
- Gateway Unified School District \$6,250 for physical empowerment project continuation
- Hayfork Elementary School \$10,000 for track & fields
- Mountain View Middle School \$6,200 for baseball dugouts & equipment
- Redding School of the Arts \$3,500 for visual art portfolio series development
- Sequoia Middle School \$6,736 for wrestling mat
- Shasta Lake School \$4,220 for marching band uniforms
- Shasta Union Elementary School \$7,500 for choral risers and band instruments
- Trinity Center Elementary \$13,000 for playground equipment
- West Valley High School \$9,384 football and baseball equipment
