Redding Rancheria's Largest Fundraiser Goes to Neverland

Redding, CA (March 16, 2009): More than 370 community members came together and helped our Neverland Celebration for the 2009 Redding Rancheria's A Year to Remember annual fundraiser dinner on Saturday, March 7.

"I wondered how we would surpass last year's theme of Alice in Wonderland, but this event was truly the most successful fundraiser dinner we have had raising approximately \$26,000 for the Redding Rancheria Community Fund. We are grateful for the continued support we receive from the community in growing this beneficial fund," said Maria Orozco, Director of Public Relations for the Redding Rancheria.

During the Peter Pan themed dinner, two local organizations were awarded \$2,500 and one special choice was awarded \$5,000. The two recipients of \$2,500 were the Shasta Chemical People and the Anderson Teen Center. Shasta Community Health Center's Hope Van received the \$5,000 gift.

All proceeds from Saturday's dinner will go to benefit the 2009 RRCF. The Redding Rancheria Community Fund (RRCF) has designated funding for 2009 towards the homeless. The RRCF has donated over \$1.3 million since its inception in 2002. A total of 42 organizations received funds in 2008.
