The Stillwater pow wow is a community gathering to showcase traditional dancing, drumming, food and jewelry in a cultural atmosphere to all families free from alcohol, drugs and smoking.

The admission price for the Stillwater Pow Wow is \$3.00.

Each night will begin with a grand entry which includes an entrance by the Hu' Puus Witam, all Native American color guard, and followed by greetings from our local dignitaries. Following the grand entry will be various competitions such as drumming, dancing and an overall competition for Miss, Jr. Miss and Little Miss Stillwater. There will be specialty dancing from various dancers from across the State including Folklorico.
