Redding Rancheria Community Fund Awards \$79,200 to 29 Organizations

Redding, CA (June 5, 2012): The Redding Rancheria Community Fund a fund by the Shasta Regional Community Foundation announces grant funding to 29 local organizations in Shasta and Trinity Counties in the amount of \$79,200.
